POPULATE THE MAP

Record systems, vendors, locations, and processing activities as part of normal work

Record systems, vendors, locations, and processing activities as part of normal assessment and governance work, or import them from existing registers.



Systems and Processors

Import from Excel or CSV, or register through assessment workflows.



Locations and Transfers

Geographic context linked to systems and suppliers for transfer visibility.



Assessment Discovery

Entities identified during assessment work surfaced as draft map entries.



Multi-format Import

Bring data maps from other compliance platforms such as TrustArc, Nymity, or enterprise formats into Acompli with AI-assisted mapping and a merge option that layers new data onto existing records.

VISUALISATION

See relationships, geography, and source evidence together



Graph View

Explore how systems, suppliers, locations, and processing activities connect visually. Interactive, filterable, and linked to underlying records.



Geographic View

Review domestic and cross-border flows by country and region for transfer governance.



Data Lineage

Trace any node back to the assessment, answer, or record that created it.



Confidence Signals

Distinguish evidence-backed records from imported or manually entered items that may still require validation.

READINESS CHECKS

Verify the map before it is shared

Readiness checks confirm that critical inputs are present. Consistency analysis surfaces orphaned nodes, conflicting routes, and outdated relationships before publication.

The result is a data map your team can explain, review, and defend.

TRANSFER GOVERNANCE

Cross-border transfers remain linked to the mechanism behind them

Whether SCCs, adequacy, or another safeguard, teams can understand what changes if a vendor moves or a safeguard expires.



Transfer Mechanisms

SCCs, adequacy decisions, and supplementary measures linked to each cross-border flow.



Transfer Impact Assessments

TIAs connected to the specific flows they cover, with links to supplier and location records.



Safeguard Monitoring

Track when mechanisms expire or require renewal, with visibility across dependent flows.

PRINCIPLE →

Transfers remain linked to their safeguard so changes propagate across dependent flows.

REVIEW AND PUBLISH

Governed review with full audit trail

Data map entries move through review with named users, timestamps, version history, and an audit trail behind each approved change.

DATA

CSV

Structured data for filtering, pivoting, and internal compliance reporting.

REPORT

PDF

Formatted reports for regulators, auditors, and governance committees.

API

API export

Structured data feed for connected platforms and internal systems.

GOVERNANCE

Attestation

Named stewards, review cadence, version history, and audit trail for each change.

CONNECTED PLATFORM

The map stays current because it is informed by the same workflows

The map stays current because it is informed by the same workflows used for assessments, risk, and RoPA.

Approved assessment work can propose structured mapping updates. Processing records remain aligned with the wider view of systems, recipients, transfers, and operational relationships. When upstream records change, affected map entries can be surfaced for review.
